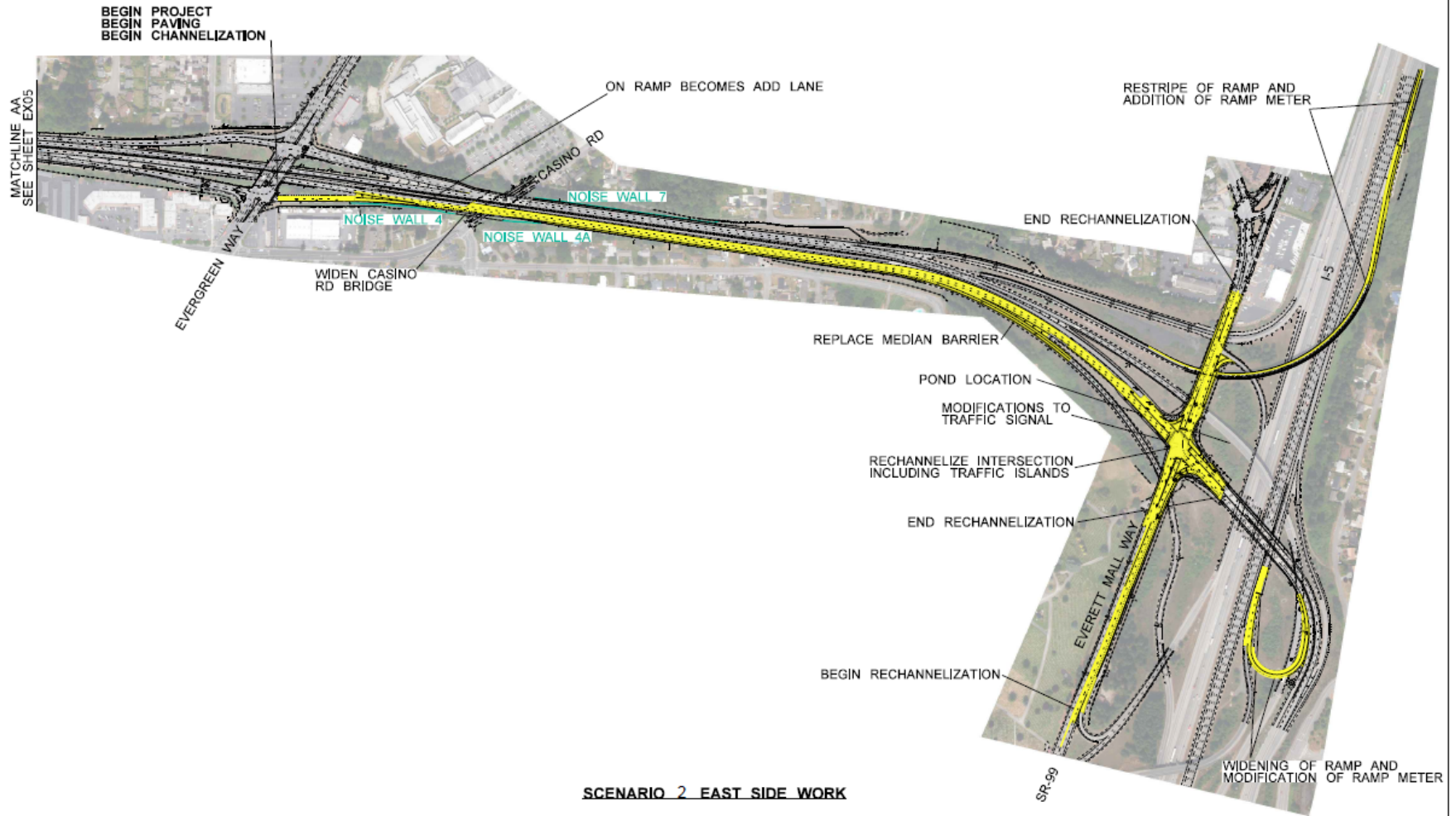

❖ Project Location



SR 526 Corridor Improvements

❖ Scope of Work

- Improvements will start from Evergreen Way to I-5:
 - Convert an existing HOV lane to create a third general-purpose lane between Evergreen Way and I-5
 - Widen the bridge over Casino Rd
 - Widen the roadway in the eastbound direction
 - Rechanelize the intersection with Everett Mall Way
 - Install ramp meters from EB SR 526 to NB I-5
 - Construct noise walls
- Other improvements
 - Repaving HMA
 - Removal and replacement of median and shoulder barriers
 - Signal modification, illumination and ITS
 - Landscaping, drainage, runoff treatment and detention

SR 526 Corridor Improvements

❖ % Design Complete

- 90% design was completed in December 2023
- 100% PS&E will be submitted August 2024

❖ Schedule

- AD Prior to Legislative Request for CPARB Review: September 16, 2025
- Revised AD to Account for CPARB Review: January 6, 2025
- Begin Construction April 2025
- Physical completion June 2027

- Bid price will need not exceed allocated funding
